Genesis 1:1

1 In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.

John 1:1-5 NLT

In the beginning the Word already existed.

The Word was with God, and the Word was God.

- John 17:1-5 NLT
- 1 After saying all these things,
 Jesus looked up to heaven and said,
 "Father, the hour has come. Glorify your Son
 so He can give glory back to You.

2 For You have given Him authority over everyone. He gives eternal life to each one You have given Him.

John 1:14

14: So the Word became human (Flesh)
and made His home among us. He was full of unfailing love and faithfulness. (grace & truth)
And we have seen His Glory,
the Glory of the Father's one and only Son.

John 1:3

God created everything through him,
and nothing was created except through him.

Colossians 1:17

17 He is before all things,
and in Him all things hold together.

John 1:4

4 The Word gave life to everything that was created, and His Life brought Light to everyone.

- 1 John 1:1-4
- 1 We proclaim to you the One who existed from the beginning, whom we have heard and seen. We saw Him with our own eyes and touched Him with our own hands. He is the Word of Life.
- This One who is Life Itself was revealed to us, and we have seen Him. And now we testify and proclaim to you that He is the One who is Eternal Life. He was with the Father, and then He was revealed to us.

- 1 John 1:3-4
- We proclaim to you what we ourselves have actually seen and heard so that you may have fellowship with us.

 And our fellowship is with the Father and with His Son, Jesus Christ.
- 4 We are writing these things so that you may fully share our joy.

John 1:5

5 The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness can never extinguish it.

The Age of Enlightenment

1700's (18th Cent) -> 1620

Insight, understanding, awareness, wisdom, education, learning, knowledge,...

It was a reaction against the church and Christianity which they dubbed (Dark Ages)

Centered on reason as the primary source of all authority.

Descartes, Locke, Kant, Goethe, Voltaire, Rousseau,

Paved the way for the political revolutions of the 18th and 19th centuries.
