1 ase careful to obey all the commands 1 am giving you today. Then you will dive and multiply, and you will enter and occupy the land the LORD
swore to give your ancestors.

Remember how the LORD your God led you through the willderness for these forty years, humbling you and testing you to prove your character. and to flind out whether or not you would obey mis commands.

3 Yes, He humbled you by letting you go hungry and then feeding you with manna, a food previously unknown to you and your ancestors. He did dit to teach you that peopledo not live by bread alone; rather. we live by every word that comes from the mouth of the LORD.

10 When you have eaten your fill, be sure to pralse the LORD your God for the good land He has given you.

11 crat that is the time to be carefuly Beware that in your plenty you do not forget the LORD your God and disobey His commands, regulations, and decrees that I am giving you today.

12 For when you have become full and prosperous and have built fline homes to live in,
13 and when your flocks and herds have become very large and your silver and gold have multiplied allong with everything else, be carefulu!

14 Do not become proud at that time and forget the LORD your God, Who rescued you from slavery on the land of Egypt.

15 Do not forget that Me led you through the great and terrifying wilderness with its poisonous snakes and scorpions, where it was so hot and dry. He gave you water from the rock!

16 He fed you with manna in the willderness, a food unknown to your ancestors. He aljo this to humble you and test you for your own good.

17 He didd all this so you would never say to yourself,
it have achieved this wealith
with my own strengith and energy.?

18 Remember the LORD your God. He is the One who gives you power to be successfiul, in order to fulfill the covenant He conflimed to your ancestiors with an oath.

## 19 "But I assure you of this:

 Of you ever forget the LORD your God and follow other gods, worshiping and bowing down to them, you will certaindly be destroyed.20 Just as the LORD has destroyed other nations in your path, you also widl be destroyed if you refuse to obey the LORD your God.
