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Romans 3:1-20 Humanity judged

1 Then what advantage has the Jew? Or what is the benefit of circumcision?

Romans 3:1 Remaining arguments: -Jewish exception 2 Great in every respect. First of all, that they were entrusted with the oracles of God.

Romans 3:2 Remaining arguments: -Jewish exception

Blessing but no exception 3 What then? If some did not believe, their unbelief will not nullify the faithfulness of God, will it?

Romans 3:3 Remaining arguments: -God promised to be faithful 4 May it never be! Rather, let God be found true, though every man be found a liar, as it is written, THAT YOU MAY BE JUSTIFIED IN YOUR WORDS, AND PREVAIL WHEN YOU ARE JUDGED."

Romans 3:4 Remaining arguments: -God promised to be faithful

God is faithful to blessings and to judgement 5 But if our unrighteousness demonstrates the righteousness of God, what shall we say? The God who inflicts wrath is not unrighteous, is He? (I am speaking in human terms.)

Romans 3:5

Remaining arguments: -God's glory displayed 6 May it never be! For otherwise, how will God judge the world?

Romans 3:6 Remaining arguments: -God's glory displayed

God's glory and justice cannot change 7 But if through my lie the truth of God abounded to His glory, why am I also still being judged as a sinner?

Romans 3:7 Remaining arguments: -God's glory benefits 8 And why not say (as we are slanderously reported and as some claim that we say), "Let us do evil that good may come"? Their condemnation is just.

Romans 3:8 Remaining arguments: -God's glory benefits

That good results from evil is a condemned conclusion

9 What then? Are we better than they?

Romans 3:9 What can we conclude? What is our defense? Are we in a worse case?

9 What then? Are we better than they? Not at all; for we have already charged that both Jews and Greeks are all under sin;

Romans 3:9 Conclusion: In light of judgement we are all the same
