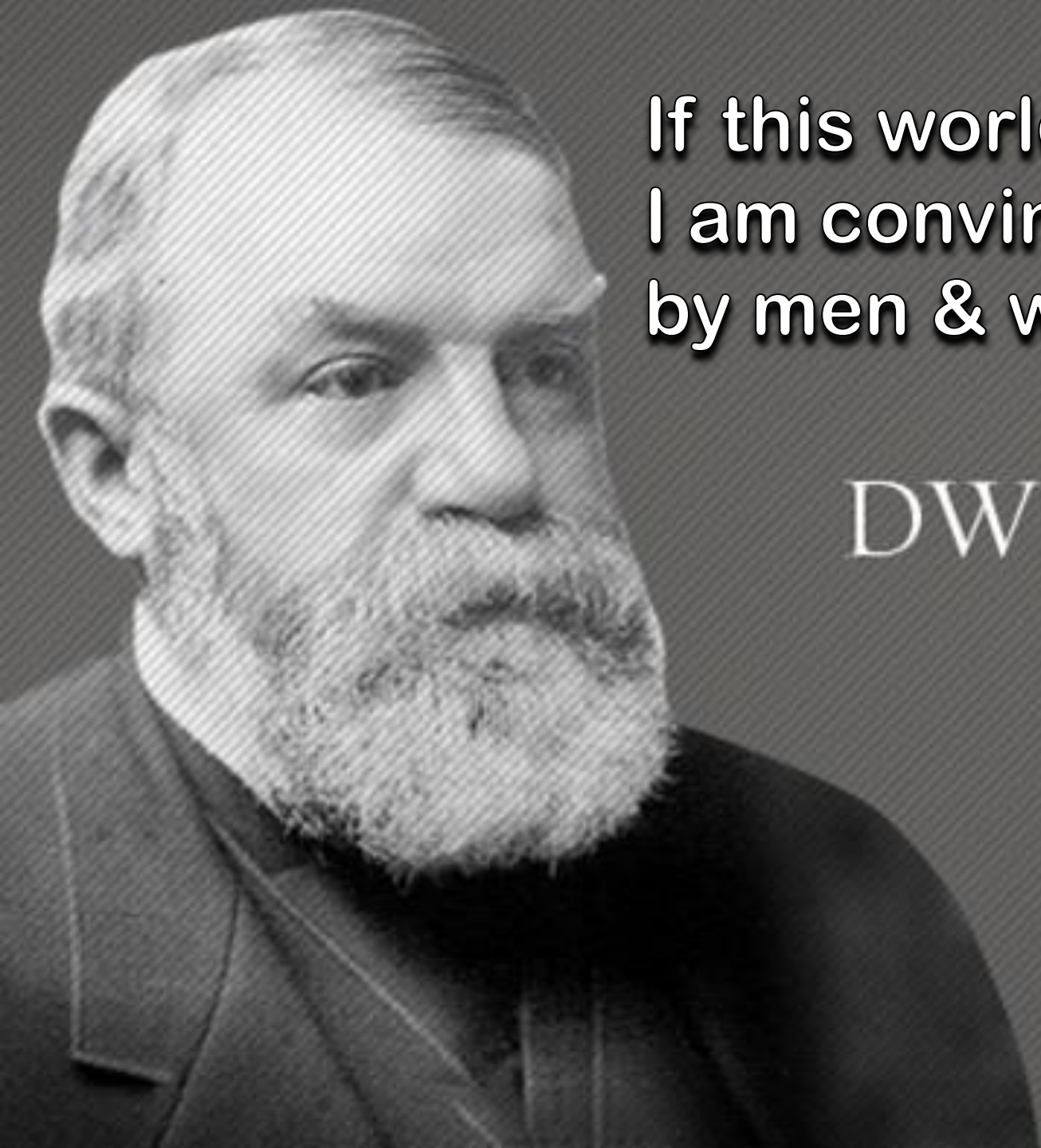

1837–1899

D.L. Moody was lead to the Lord
in the back of a shoe store,
by **Mr. Kimball**, a Sunday school teacher.

Mr. Henry Varley in Dublin, England changed
D. L. Moody's life when he said,
“**The world is yet to see what God will do**
with and for and through and in and by
the man who was fully consecrated to Him.”

“He said a man, he did not say **a great man, a learned man, a smart man**. He just simply said **a man**. I am a man. And it lies within me whether I will or I will not make this full consecration to God.

I will do my best to be that man.”

Moody became the most powerful influential man for God, a layman, in the 19th century. He shared the Gospel with over a 100 million people.

Peter Heals a Crippled Beggar

- 1 Peter and John went to the Temple one afternoon to take part in the three o'clock **prayer service**.

2 As they approached the Temple,
a man lame from birth was being carried in.
Each day he was put beside the Temple gate,
the one called the Beautiful Gate,
so he could beg
from the people going into the Temple.

3 When he saw Peter and John about to enter,
he **asked them for some money.**

4 Peter and John looked at him intently,
and Peter said, "**Look at us!**"

5 The lame man looked at them **eagerly,**
expecting some money.

6 But Peter said,
“I don’t have any silver or gold for you.
But I’ll give you what I have.

In the name of Jesus Christ the Nazarene,
get up and walk!”

7 Then Peter took the lame man by the right hand and helped him up. And as he did, the man's feet and ankles were instantly healed and strengthened.

8 He jumped up, stood on his feet, and began to walk!
Then, walking, leaping, and praising God, he went into the Temple with them.

9 All the people saw him walking and heard him **praising God**.

10 When they realized he was the lame beggar they had seen so often at the Beautiful Gate, they were **absolutely astounded!**

11 They all rushed out in amazement to Solomon's Colonnade, where the man was holding tightly to Peter and John.

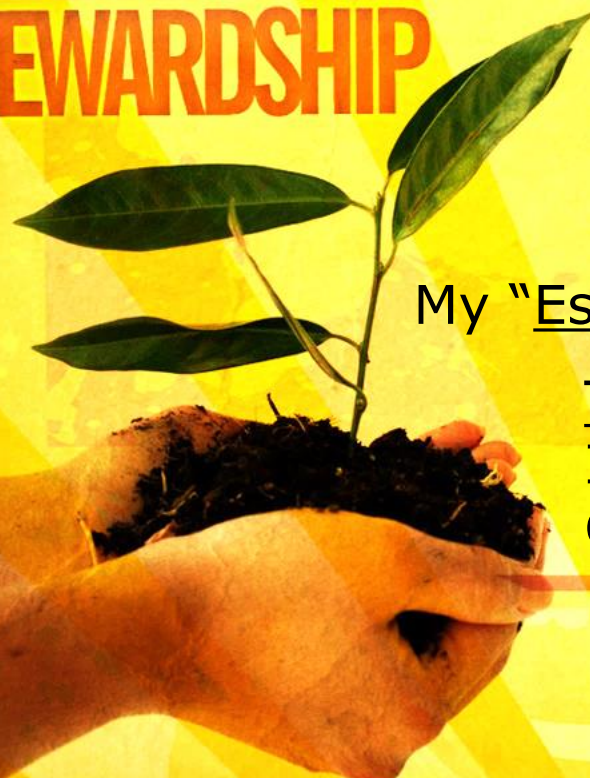
