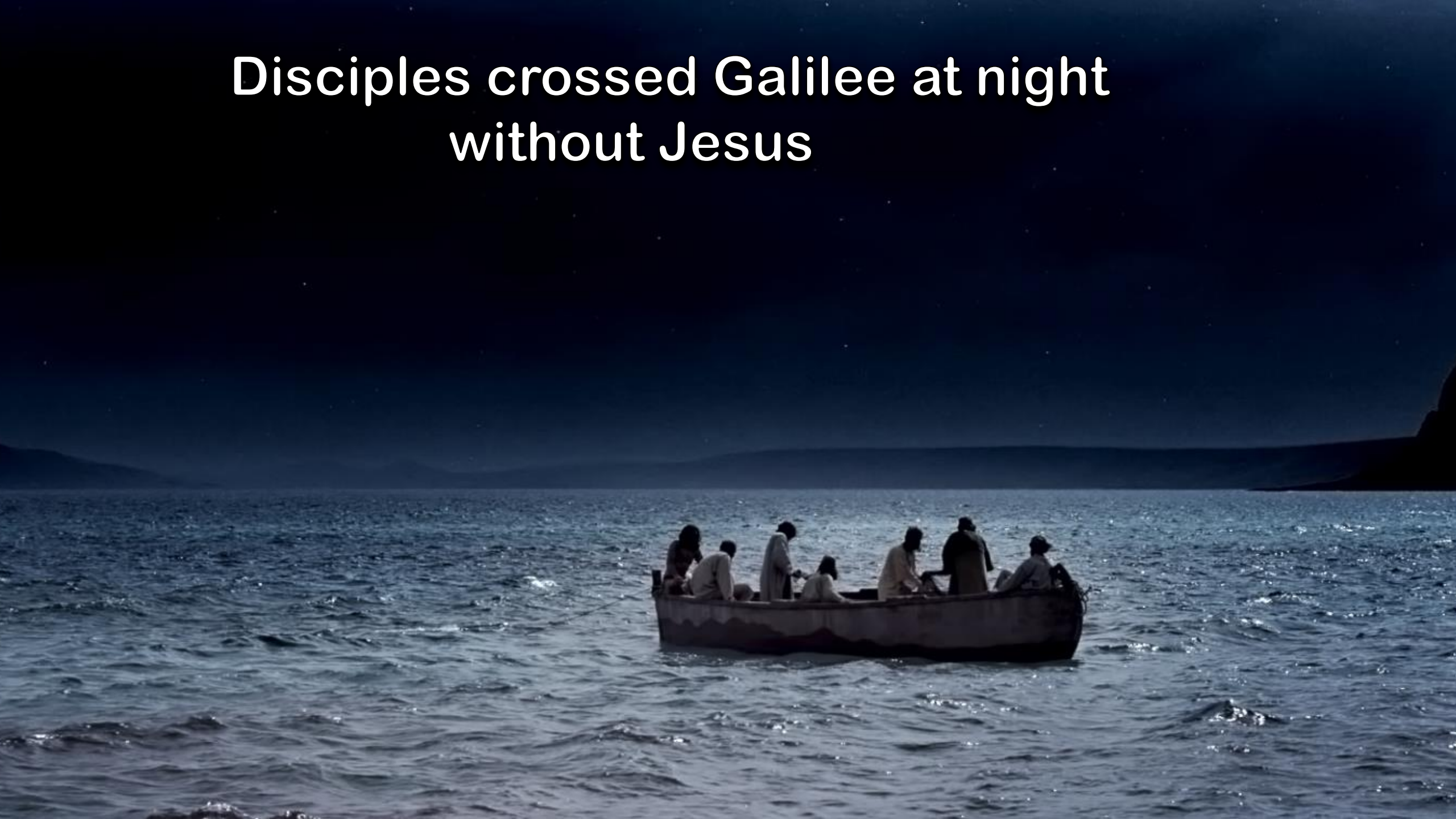

32 But don't be so concerned about

Believe in the One He has sent.”

30 “Show us a miraculous sign if you want us
to believe in You. What can You do?”

31 After all, our ancestors ate **manna**
while they journeyed through the wilderness!

The Scriptures say,


‘**Moses** gave them **bread from heaven** to eat.’”



32 Jesus said, “I tell you **the truth**,
Moses didn't give you bread from heaven.
My Father did.
& now He offers you **the True Bread from heaven.**

33 **The True Bread of God** is the One Who
comes down from heaven & **gives life to the world.**”

34 “Sir,” they said, “give us that bread every day.”

35 Jesus replied, "I am the Bread of Life.
Whoever **comes to Me** will never be hungry again.
Whoever **believes in Me** will never be thirsty.

47 "I tell you **the truth,**
anyone who believes has eternal life.

48 Yes, I am the Bread of Life!

49 Your ancestors ate **manna** in the wilderness,
but they all died.

50 Anyone who eats the Bread from Heaven, however, will never die.

51 I Am the Living Bread  that came down from Heaven. Anyone who eats this Bread will live forever; and this Bread, which I will offer so the world may live, is My Flesh.”

52 Then the people began arguing with each other about what He meant. “How can this Man give us His Flesh to eat?” they asked.

53 So Jesus said again, “I tell you **the truth**,
unless you **eat the Flesh of the Son of Man**
and **drink His Blood**,
you cannot have eternal life within you.

54 But anyone who eats My Flesh
and drinks My Blood **has eternal life**,
and I will raise that person at the last day.




55 For **My Flesh is True Food,**
and **My Blood is True Drink.**

56 Anyone who eats My Flesh and drinks My Blood
remains in Me, and I in him.

57 I live because of the Living Father who sent Me;
in the same way, anyone who **feeds on Me**
will live because of Me.





58 **I Am the True Bread** that came down from heaven. Anyone who **eats This Bread** will not die as your ancestors did (even though they ate the manna) but **will live forever.**”

59 He said these things while He was teaching in the synagogue in **Capernaum.**



BREAD OF LIFE

THAT WE MAY BE MADE WHOLE

- 60 Many of His disciples said,
“This is very hard to understand.
How can anyone accept it?”
- 61 Jesus was aware that His disciples
were complaining, so He said to them,
“Does this offend you?”
- 62 Then what will you think if you see
the **Son of Man ascend to Heaven** again?

63 **The Spirit alone gives eternal life.**
Human effort accomplishes nothing.
And the very words I have spoken to you
are Spirit and Life.

64 **But some of you do not believe Me.”**
(For Jesus knew from the beginning
which ones didn't believe,
and **He knew who would betray Him.**)

65 Then He said,
“That is why I said that **people can't come to Me**
unless the Father gives them to Me.”

66 At this point **many of His disciples**
turned away and deserted Him.

67 Then Jesus turned to the Twelve and asked,
“**Are you also going to leave?**”

68 Simon Peter replied,
“Lord, to whom would we go?
You have the words that give Eternal Life.”

69 We believe,
and we know You are the Holy One of God.”
